

## Ministering to the Next Generation of Leaders



As part of our mission to develop military Christian leaders worldwide, ACCTS has several programs and short-term mission trip opportunities that introduce young U.S. and international military personnel to military ministry. These programs help participants to:

- † view their military careers as a calling from God;
- † meet their military counterparts in other countries;
- † learn to integrate their faith with their military careers to serve as ambassadors for Christ;
- † develop a vision for international ministry; and,

† grow in appreciation for other countries' history, culture, and value systems.

ACCTS' Exploration Programs (AEP) are short-term mission trips that help U.S. cadets and midshipmen meet military Christians in other nations, visit those countries' military academies, and travel to historic and cultural sites with members of international military Christian fellowships.



These AEP trips are conducted during U.S. military service academies' Spring Breaks and are coordinated with Christian groups at those academies.

Our Waterloo to World War II program is a two-week leadership course that takes young military personnel to battlefields and historic sites in Europe while teaching them lessons in leadership, from the Napoleonic wars through both world wars.



Interaction-Rocky Mountain High is a two-week outdoor adventure course, held in Colorado, for international and U.S. military personnel that combines activities such as mountain climbing and rappelling with leadership and military ministry lessons.

ACCTS also offers young military personnel the opportunity to participate in **summer ministry trips** to Asia, which can include teaching English to military personnel and civilians, interacting with Asian military Christians and non-Christians, and visiting cultural sites.
