Response to an Immoral Order

- **Military Setting: Vietnam 1964**
- **Immoral Order: Disarm, strip, and abandon rebellious troops.**
- **My Response: Disarm only and wait for transportation.**
- **Biblical example: 1 Samuel 25:13,22,25-28**
- **COA's: Determine lawfulness of order, if order violates conscience, offer alternative**

“When he took the video to the intelligence officer, he was warned to be careful since that soldier was not alone in this. But he involved some big shots.”

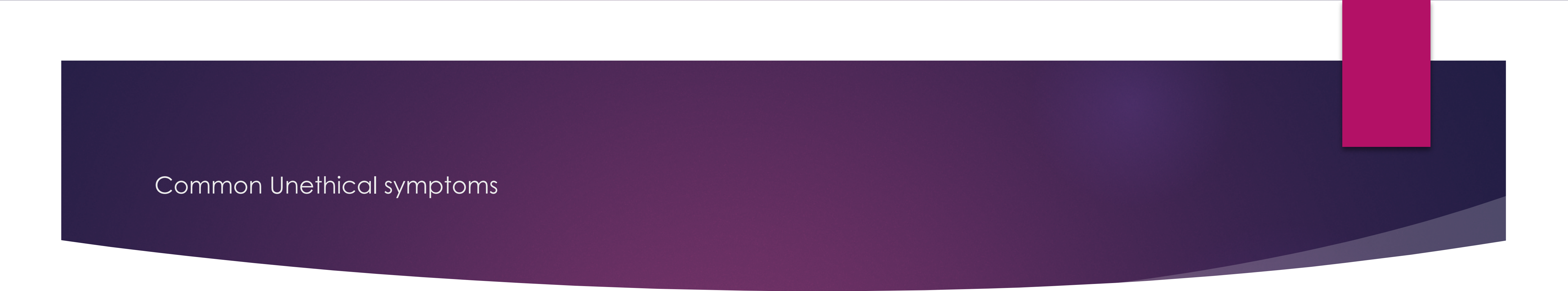
