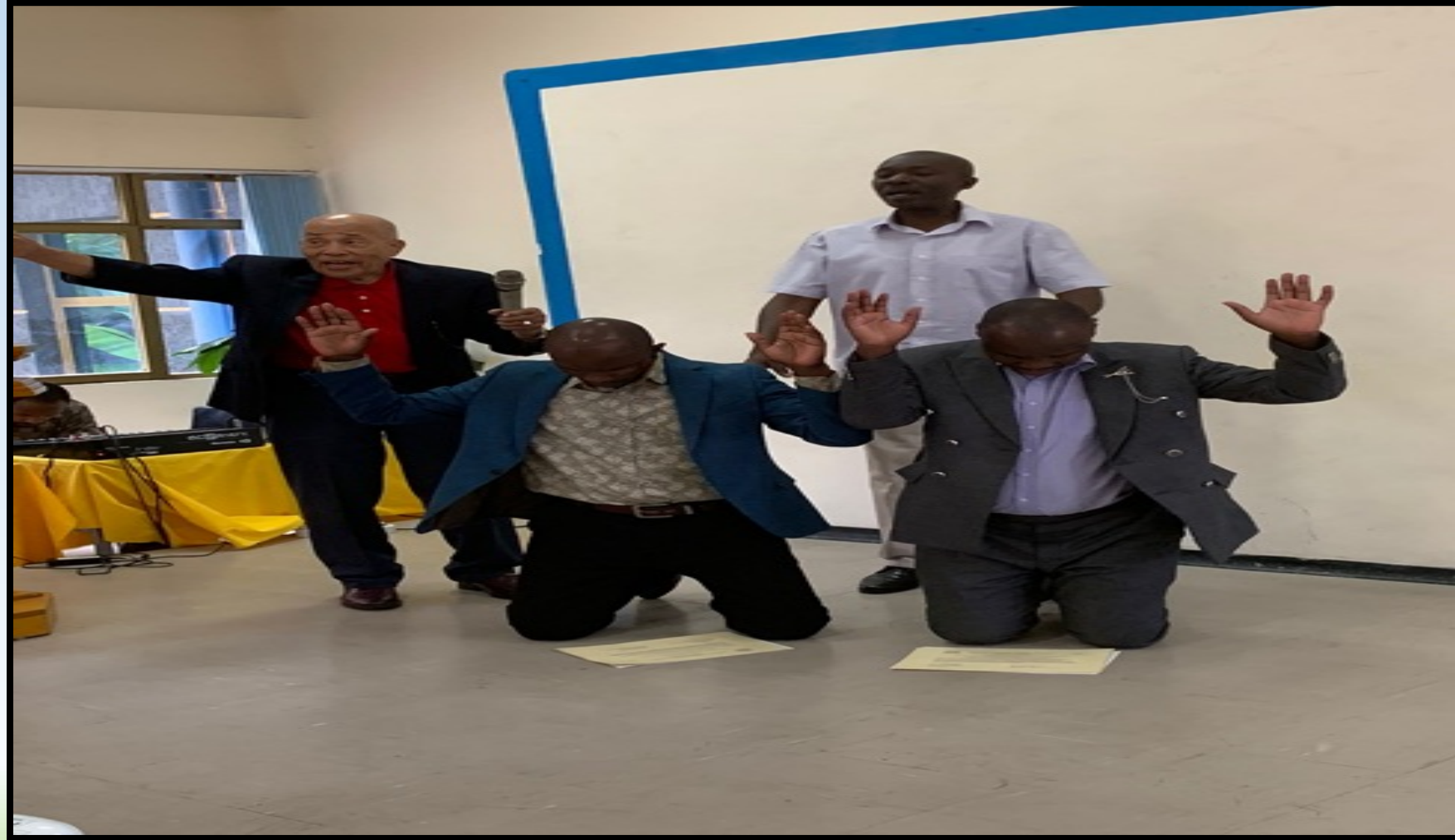

Maj. Rev. Yusuf Abaganda (Kenya Defense Forces) reflects on his experience as an ACCTS intern as both impactful and formative, emphasizing practical mentorship within his unit **through small group discussions, peer pairing, and real-life scenario reflections that promote values like integrity, discipline, and accountability.** He highlights fostering ethical decision-making and encouraging daily acts of service, noting visible personal growth and strong bonds formed during deployment.

At the same time, he acknowledges the challenges of operating in a **multi-faith environment, addressing them by focusing on shared values,** keeping participation voluntary, encouraging respectful dialogue, and leading by consistent example **to build trust and inclusivity** while remaining grounded in his Christian faith.

The three Commands that shape Biblical Military Ethics

### 1. Act Justly

Justice is not merely a principle—it is an action.

In operations, discipline, administration, and command decisions, we must ask:  
**"What is the right thing to do—not the easy thing?"**



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## 2. Love Mercy

Mercy is not softness—it is controlled strength.

Mercy means treating people with dignity because they bear the image of God.

It means balancing truth with compassion.

It also means resisting the temptation to respond out of anger, wounded pride, or retaliation.
