

CELEBRATING IN ROMANIA

Ten years of sharing Christ with Romania's military personnel is cause for celebration, and that's what nearly 60 members of Romania's military Christian fellowship, Cornelius, did in October. They gathered to remember how God has led them and the leaders who helped the MCF grow, and prayed about how they will impact their nation for Christ in the future.

ACCTS staff members Eduard Rosca (from Moldova) and Dick Barnes (from the USA) attended this celebration. Dick, who was at the formation meeting ten years ago, brought with him two suitcases' worth of audio Bibles in several languages for the MCF to distribute. These Bibles are from Faith Comes by Hearing, an ACCTS partner organization which provides audio Bibles, on MP3 players, in over 920 languages.

Several MCF members shared how they were drawn to faith in Christ, including Vasile, who grew up an atheist and had dedicated his life to military service. When Vasile married his wife, Cornelia, he initially wouldn't allow her to mention God in their house. Because of her faithful prayers, however, he came to know Jesus and is now a committed and active Christian who ministers to Romania's police forces.
