

Chaplains Interaction Follow-up

Although ACCTS training programs like Chaplains Interaction only last two weeks, their effects last for years as participants implement new ministry goals in their home nations. Chaplain James Corbin of Guyana, who attended Chaplains Interaction 2017 in March, recently shared what he is planning for military ministry: “We are thankful for the experience and training of Chaplains Interaction 2017. I am in the middle of completing my draft report, after which I intend to present an action to my commander. My prayer is that it will be implemented over the next two years, as a result of my participation in CI 2017. Notwithstanding, I have three basic goals towards which I am working: My top priority is the formation and certification of the local chaplains Corp. of the GDF [Guyana Defence Force], using ACCTS training curriculum I received. It will be slightly customized into three modules. My other priority is the coordination of the GDF participation, in hosting of an ACCTS CI in Guyana in 2018. Finally, I wish for you to consider certifying persons trained here with the ACCTS [Chaplains Interaction training] certificate.”
